It's also important for your child that he/she sees you reading as well. Children are great observers (even when we think they are not paying attention) and they mimic our examples. (More suggestions are on reverse.)

Over the next couple of weeks we will be covering the following material . . .

Religion: We recently finished our unit on the celebration of the Mass. In this next section the children will learn how we can share God's love. When we pray we show God that we love Him. Language Arts: Every day there are new sound combinations introduced and/or reviewed. Our focus the next two weeks will include "bossy r" words (r-controlled vowels such as *ur*, *ar*, *or*, *er*, and *ear*), digraphs such as *th*, *wh*, and *sh*, and long and short vowel combinations. We will also be working with prefixes, antonyms, synonyms and contractions. *SLE 2d*, *4b*

Reading: Our new unit is called "I am Brave". The story selections focus on how people can overcome their fears. We will explore the genres of realistic fiction and fantasy. In conjunction with this unit the children are also writing stories and illustrating them. *SLE 2a, 3c*

Math: Chapter 12 explores fractions and the basics of probability. We will learn that fractions are part of a whole or part of a set. The children will also become familiar with probability using terms such as "certain", "possible" and "impossible". *SLE 5a*, *5c* For more information please go to <u>www.sadlier.com/math</u>.
